As a program endorsed by UVM, TWC's Academic Internship Program is a great complement to your studies. The Washington Center allows you to gain practical, real-world experience that will help you transform your major into an exciting career.

Cost for UVM Students

The Washington Center has partnered with UVM and you can expect to pay the following amounts:

Fall/Spring

- **Program Fee:** \$0
- **Housing Fee (if in-person):** \$6,570
- **Tuition:** Your normal tuition to UVM

Summer

- **Program Fee:** \$0
- **Housing Fee:** \$4,990
- **Tuition:** UVM summer tuition for 12 credits ([rates here](#))

You will be responsible for transportation costs to and from D.C., along with your daily living expenses. This cost could be offset by financial assistance through your UVM SFS and/or through TWC. To find out how much financial assistance you could be eligible for, make sure to:

- Check with UVM Student Financial Services to see if your aid package can be applied toward TWC housing costs (TWC is considered "off-campus" housing)
- Review scholarships available through TWC at www.twc.edu/cost
- Contact info@twc.edu to inquire about any additional funding opportunities that may be available to you

Credit Arrangements for UVM

You can expect to earn the following amount of credit for your participation in The Washington Center Academic Internship Program.

Fall/Spring Credit: 15 UVM credits

Summer Credit: 12 UVM credits

You will enroll in UVM credit numbers AS 096, AS 190, and AS 196, which count as elective credit. If you wish to count any of these credits toward your major or minor, you are responsible for getting permission from your Department Chair. At the end of the semester, TWC will send your grades to UVM and they will be entered in the normal way.
