Course Schedule Required for Completion of Communication Sciences MS Program: 2023-2025

Students must have completed all pre-requisite courses prior to the start of graduate course work in CSD. Comparable courses taken at the UG level, through CDE, or at another institution <u>may</u> not need to be repeated and <u>may</u> make room for elective courses. (See electives.) Students are required to enroll in Clinical Study, CSD 6210-6250, for each semester they are active in the program. In total, 48-56 credits of graduate coursework are required for the non-thesis track and 51-59 credits of graduate coursework for students who write a thesis. Equivalent graduate level coursework may be used to waive up to a maximum of nine credits, if approved by the graduate program coordinator, reducing the total number of in-residence credits needed for completion of the program.
