Honors theses

Students wanting to write honors theses for College
Honors in their senior year should take the relevant
preparatory courses by the end of their junior year.
For many, this will mean taking Econometrics EC
200 in the Fall semester of their junior year. But
they should also take other relevant courses as well
(trade, labor, etc., depending on area of interest).
Students who will not do an empirical thesis should
take other advanced courses by the end of their
junior year as well. They should be advised to have
a topic, advisor and plan of action by the end of
their junior year and work on the proposal over the
following summer.

Department honors

Students wanting to apply for Economics
Department Honors do so in the Spring Semester of
their senior year. To apply, submit the best research
paper written for an Economics course, with a cover
essay. Such students should start 200-level
coursework early.
