An independent study is a course that is tailored to fit the interests of a specific student, and which occurs outside the traditional classroom/laboratory setting under the direct supervision of a faculty member. Independent study projects may not duplicate existing course offerings.

Independent study may be taken for variable credit. The amount of credit to be granted should be mutually agreed upon by the student and the faculty sponsor prior to registration. Independent study projects should match the per-credit workload expectations of conventional courses.

Proposal for Independent Studies in English

The plan should include the following.

- 1. The project title.
- 2. A statement of justification indicating why independent study is being selected.

- 3. A plan for when the student and faculty member will meet and discuss progress, including any relevant deadlines for parts of the work.
- 4. A plan for evaluation, including the specific work to be submitted for evaluation and criteria to be used for evaluation.
