MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR ADMISSION IN THE UVM MECHANICAL ENGINEERING GRADUATE PROGRAM

Background:

Students entering the program have generally received a Bachelor's degree in mechanical engineering or a closely-related field in engineering. Applicants with other backgrounds outside engineering will be evaluated individually and may be required to first complete undergraduate technical course work in the first semester, as prescribed by the graduate program director.

Admission deadlines:

January 15 for fall admissions (for PhD students, applications may be accepted until June 15)
October 15 for spring admissions

Minimum required GPA:

3.0/4.0 in both BS and MS degrees for all students 3.2/4.0 for UVM students wishing to enter the accelerated MS program

GRE test scores:

GRE scores are required for all students, except for applicants to the accelerated MS program, and must be within the last 5 years.

ALL GRE REQUIREMENTS ARE CURRENTLY WAIVED FOR FALL 2021 ADMISSIONS.

English Proficiency Examination (for international students only):

Applicants whose native language is not English are required to submit proof of English proficiency. Applicants must submit official scores of either the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL), the International English Language Testing System (IELTS), or Duolingo.
