

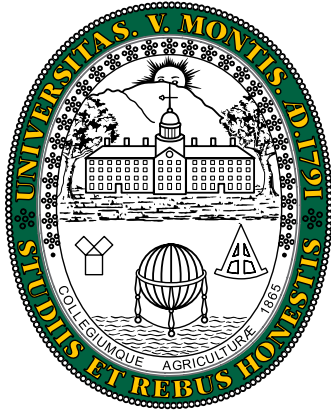

Congratulations to the UVM authors of 2017. Thank you from a grateful University for so widely sharing your passions and intellectual pursuits!

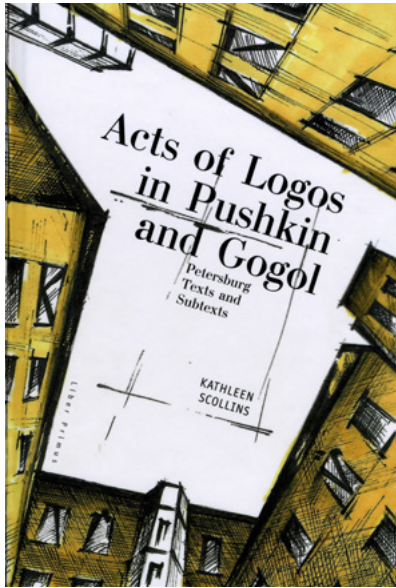
