 - **Re:** A Proposal by CNHS for a No Contest Termination of the Integrative Health Care Certificate Program

On April 7th, 2022, the Curricular Affairs Committee (CAC) unanimously approved a request by the College of Nursing & Health Sciences (CNHS) to terminate their undergraduate certificate program in Integrative Health Care because our approval of their proposal for a new minor in Integrative Health Care makes this program redundant.

Currently there are 36 students enrolled in the certificate program and all will be given the option of completing the certificate or transferring to the minor. The PACE Certificate in Integrative Health Care will remain unchanged. There will be no changes in faculty or staffing.

The no-contest termination is supported by the Department of Rehabilitation and Movement Science (Jan 13, 2022: vote 15:1 in support of termination) and has the unanimous support of the CNHS Curriculum Committee (Jan 17, 2022).

If approved by the Board of Trustees, the no contest termination would go into effect for Fall 2022.
