**Re:** Report out on Items voted on by the Curricular Affairs Committee that do not require Faculty Senate vote

On December 7, 2023, the Curricular Affairs Committee approved the actions recommended in the following memo.

The Curricular affairs committee approved the following motions that do not require voting by the Faculty Senate:

- I. Approval of new course prefix for Plant and Soil Sciences (PSS) courses: Agriculture, Landscape and the Environment (ALE). All current PSS courses will be converted to this course prefix for the 24-25 catalog. Note: This curricular action is in conjunction with a proposal to change the name of the Plant and Soil Sciences Department to Agriculture, Landscape and the Environment Department which the faculty senate will vote on December 18, 2023.
- II. Approval of a new course prefix for the Electrical Engineering (EE) courses: Electrical and Computer Engineering (CMPE). All current EE courses will be converted to the new course prefix CMPE for the 24-25 catalog. Note: This curricular action is in conjunction with a proposal to change the name of the Electrical Engineering program to Electrical and Computer Engineering (ECE) which the faculty senate will vote on December 18, 2023.
- III. Approved receipt of two APR reports for Medical Education and Medical Laboratory Sciences.
