The Faculty Senate is seeking **nominations for Vice President of the Faculty Senate**. The 2-year term will take effect on July 1, 2023 and end on June 30, 2025.

Deadline for Nominations - Nominations will be accepted from the floor of the Faculty Senate on **Monday, February 27, 2023**, 4:00 – 5:30 p.m. on Teams. Self-nominations are encouraged. Nominations may also be submitted online via [webform](#) no later than 6:00 p.m. on **Monday, March 6, 2023**. The election will be held by electronic ballot, distributed via email to all eligible faculty members in March 2023. The ballot will be open for one-week.

Faculty Senate Vice President

Eligibility to serve

UVM faculty members at the rank of Professor, Associate Professor, Assistant Professor, Instructor, Senior Lecturer, Lecturer, Research Associate, Clinical Educator, Clinical Practice Physician, or Faculty Scientist, with a full-time equivalent of at least 0.10, and who may also be Chairperson, Directors, or Associate Deans are eligible. The Vice President is a member of the Faculty Senate without vote and may not also serve concurrently as an Elected Senator.

Duties of the Faculty Senate Vice President

The Faculty Senate Vice President performs the duties of the President when the latter is prevented from doing so and is an ex officio member (nonvoting except when designated according to Section 7.122 of the bylaws) of all Senate committees with the exception of the Nominating Committee. The Vice President is a voting member of the Faculty Senate Executive Council and shall serve as Chair of the Executive Council in the absence of the President. The Vice President is a nonvoting faculty representative to the Board of trustees on the Educational Policy and Institutional Resources Committee. The duties of the Faculty Senate Vice President are outlined in the Faculty Senate Constitution and Bylaws. The full document is available on the Faculty Senate website (www.uvm.edu/faculty_senate). As an officer of the Faculty Senate, the Vice President is expected to attend Faculty Senate Executive Council meetings, in addition to the Faculty Senate meetings. Both Senate and Executive Council meetings are generally held monthly on Mondays from 4:00 – 5:30 p.m.
