The Faculty Senate Student Affairs Committee approved the following revision to the Religious Holidays Policy at their meeting on May 4, 2023

PREVIOUS RELIGIOUS HOLIDAYS POLICY

Religious Holidays: Students have the right to practice the religion of their choice. Each semester students should submit in writing to their instructors by the end of the second full week of classes their documented religious holiday schedule for the semester. Faculty must permit students who miss work for the purpose of religious observance to make up this work.

Dates of religious holidays can be found on the Interfaith Calendar. Two versions are available: one is the <u>Interfaith Calendar for the current academic year (PDF)</u>, the other is a <u>multi-year Interfaith Calendar</u> (PDF).

REVISED RELIGIOUS HOLIDAYS POLICY

Religious Holidays: Religions may be practiced in many different ways, and can impact participation in classes variably. Students have the right to practice the religion of their choice. Each semester students should submit in writing to their instructors as early as possible and by the end of the second full week of classes at least one week prior to their documented religious holiday the date(s) of the conflict or absence. Faculty must permit students who miss work or exams for the purpose of religious observance to make up this work. In addition, faculty and students are encouraged to review the calendar of holidays maintained by the Interfaith Center to proactively plan course schedules and exam schedules.

Dates of religious holidays can be found on the Interfaith Calendar. Two versions are available: one is the <u>Interfaith Calendar for the current academic year (PDF)</u>, the other is a <u>multi-year Interfaith Calendar (PDF)</u>.
