- Strategic initiative growing graduate student population
 - Pre-master's Program successfully launched
 - 10 students, all doing well
 - Accelerated Master's Programs
 - UVM undergrads only
 - Early entry to Graduate Program
 - No change to graduate program
 - Grad executive review only, but require home unit Dean's support and other review as locally required
 - New requirement: Form signed by student's home Dean's Office uploaded into application
 - 6-9 credit scholarship for graduate program



 - There is no cost allocation for student head count assessed




Fall 2016 Admissions Update


