# **Discussion with Dr. Sherwood Smith**

- Dr. Sherwood Smith talked about his role at UVM
- He is the director of Center for Cultural Pluralism
- The Center for Cultural Pluralism supports diversity, engagement, and professional development
- His primary role is to make students from diverse background feel welcome at UVM and create a safe space for the development of this community
- He also discussed the different roles of the identity centers at UVM
- Dr. Smith mentioned that there are many dimensions of diversity and that individuals claim numerous identities
- Dr. Smith talked about implicit bias

- One senator asked why there is no campus wide diversity training and he suggested that GSS can organize diversity training for graduate students
- Another senator asked him how to talk about racism without making other people uncomfortable
- Graduate students who are in STEM are not required to complete any coursework or training concerning race, gender or power
- History graduate students take courses that talk about power dynamics
- English graduate program students take courses about feminism and racism
