Committee Updates:

Parking and Transportation Committee (Colin Giles)

- Met with Jim Barr from Transportation and Parking Services about:
 - Shuttle and bus service over winter break
 - Parking enforcement over winter break
 - Note: Campus will be closed December 19th – January 3rd and so there will be no parking enforcement during those times.
 - The short term temporary parking permits (i.e., the \$2/day parking permits available to everyone)

Housing Committee (Mohamed Khalife)

- Complete lack of cooperation from UVM’s administration
- The administration has no plan for Graduate housing
- We are working on a survey that will be shared with GSS before sending it out to graduate students
- We plan to meet with the international office in setting up a group of students that can assist newly accepted students with housing
- We plan to participate in the City Council meeting to discuss housing issues
- Transitional 7-day housing for incoming graduate students coming to campus for the first time

Q & A with Students

- Example of Question Asked:
“The current minimum graduate student stipend at UVM is thousands of dollars less than what is considered a “living wage”, meaning it does not cover the most basic cost of living in the

Burlington area. In fact, stipends are so low at UVM that the average graduate stipend is below a living wage. The consequences of this are quite grim. For instance, 20% of graduate students at UVM report experiencing food insecurity. With this in mind, my two questions are:

- 1) Do you feel that it is ethical and responsible for UVM to deny its graduate students a living wage?
- 2) Why do you think compensation for graduate students at UVM remains insufficient and uncompetitive?"

Lead to Discussion About:

- How low graduate student stipends are compared to the National Average
- The lack of transparency of student fees coming out of graduate student stipends before enrolling at UVM
- Graduate Student housing and how the University sold off multiple Graduate Student Housing buildings in recent years
- The added barriers international students face at UVM i.e. they are left to fend for their own when they first arrive at UVM
- Talked about how these are all problems and how they should be addressed before expanding Graduate Student enrollment for the land grant mission
