



## Getting to Burlington, VT

**\*\* *Transportation:*** Transportation from and to the airport is the responsibility of the attendee. Please note below the timing to your specific hotel from the airport and different means of passage. \*\*

### **BY CAR**

Vermont is a convenient drive from anywhere in the eastern U.S. and southern Quebec and Ontario provinces of Canada. Major interstates 89 and 91 as well as Vermont state highways and scenic byways provide direct routes to downtowns and diverse outdoor recreation.

#### **Estimated drive times to Burlington:**

- From Boston: 3hr, 20 min
- From Montreal: 1hr, 45 min
- From New York: 5 hr, 35 min
- From Ottawa: 3 hr, 40 min
- From Philadelphia: 6hr, 45 min
- From Toronto: 6 hr, 50 min
- From Washington, DC: 8hr, 50min
