Poster Preparation Guidelines for FERC 2019

Your poster must be prepared as a well-designed, high-quality print in order to facilitate scholarly discussion. Below are some guidelines for poster presentations.

Poster Dimensions & Materials

- You will be provided with:
 - o A poster board (with your number marked) that is 40 by 60 inches and mounted on an easel
 - Pins for fastening the poster to the board
- Suggested poster size is 36X48 inches (92X122 centimeters)
- Poster may be made of any material that can be pinned on cardboard
- Access to electrical outlets is limited. We suggest a printed poster instead of reliance on electric outlets / cords

Creating the Poster

- Use font size 30 point or larger. A person should be able to read the information from 5 feet (1.5 meters) away
- Use bullet points or brief amounts of text when presenting your information
- Summarize your information so attendees can get the main ideas of your project:
 - O What did you do?
 - O Why is it important?
 - o What does it mean for family business scholars and practitioners?
