

## Summer 2021 Farrell Hall Operations Plan

Dear Gund Community,

As spring semester (and a very challenging academic year) wind down, here's an update on how we will manage Farrell Hall this summer.

First, **Farrell will remain open this summer** for members of our community who want to work here. However, based on UVM's guidelines, there are some requirements to fulfill.

Farrell Hall will be locked all summer, and available only to those with approved CatCard access. **The building will be accessible 24/7 starting May 24**. Everyone will still need to check in with Nora upon arrival. If you access the building when Nora is not there, please email her a screenshot of your approved CoVerified app.

**Staff and Postdocs** coming to campus will need to continue to do their <u>Daily health checkin</u>, with Nora as their supervisor (**NetID: nshahoud**). <u>COVID-19 testing</u> is not required but will continue to be available for free.

All **graduate students** will need to continue <u>weekly COVID-19 testing</u> as well as daily health check-ins. Regular testing is required even for students who have been vaccinated. UVM may update this requirement as the summer progresses.

Any graduate students <u>not</u> enrolled in on-campus classes who opted to work remotely last semester and want to be on campus this summer must be sponsored by a faculty or staff member. Nora can handle this for you. Please email her by **May 18** and confirm you will be coming to campus from May 24 – August 27, include any dates you will be away from campus, and indicate that you have read the information in the link below.

For those who have not been coming to campus this past year, Nora will assign a room for you to use during the summer months.
