## POLICY ON STUDENT DISENROLLMENT

Adopted September 28, 2006

A student will be considered for disenrollment by the HESA faculty at the end of the first year of the program if he/she is making less than satisfactory academic progress or less than satisfactory professional progress (e.g., lack of demonstrable competence in the assistantship and/or practica). Student will be notified in writing by the HESA Coordinator of the decision of the HESA faculty. Upon disenrollment, the student can no longer take classes within the HESA program.
