Demonstration of the roller crimper to lay down a winter rye cover crop, see results of that compared to sickle bar mowed rye, powered cultivation and traditional black plastic for weed management. Demonstration of cultivation tools with [Dr. Eric Gallandt's](#) team. Discuss crop rotation, disease reduction, and common insect pests.
