

# Follow this study abroad timeline:

## 9-12 months before studying abroad

- Apply for or renew your passport
- Attend a **Study Abroad 101 session** and activate your iAbroad account
- Meet with your Academic Advisor and complete the Academic Advising form
- Research study abroad programs using iAbroad's search function
- Fully explore financial considerations for your study abroad experience
- Consider medications you take regularly and verify they are legal in desired host country
- Review visa information for your desired host country. Pay close attention to the visa application timeline and requirements.
- **Complete iAbroad Inquiry phase**

## 5-8 months before studying abroad

- Apply to study abroad program (must apply by the UVM application deadline)
- **Complete iAbroad Apply phase**
- Receive a placement/acceptance decision
- Verify your health insurance covers you while abroad

## After acceptance into a study abroad program

- Confirm your participation in your study abroad program and fulfill the program/university's enrollment requirements
- Finalize your UVM budget sheet
- **Complete iAbroad Conditional Acceptance phase**  
(Note: This phase can take 3-4 weeks to complete)
- Make an appointment for health consultations and any required immunizations
- Apply for your visa to study in your host country (if required)
- Attend UVM Pre-departure Orientation
- **Complete iAbroad Pre-departure phase**  
(Note: This phase should be completed no later than the last day of classes in the semester preceding your study abroad program)
- Pack with intention, taking entry documents, emergency contact info, etc.

## Application Deadlines:

### Summer/Fall/Academic Year

Exchange: January 10

External/Direct: February 15

### Spring/Calendar Year

Exchange: August 10

External/Direct: September 15

1. Go to <https://iabroad.uvm.edu>.
2. Explore program options using the iAbroad search function
3. Toward the bottom left-hand corner, click on "Inquiry Phase" to login to your iAbroad account.
