Dear RSENR Community,

With resumption plans approved and the semester just around the corner, we are updating our guidance and policies regarding Aiken building access. As a reminder, any employee with a work location status of <u>in-person or both</u> must fill in the <u>UVM Daily Health Check-in</u> every workday, even if they are not going to be on campus.

\*\*\*Graduate students will be using a different system. We're still waiting for guidance from UVM.\*\*\*

- 1. Workday access (7am-6pm):
  - Remote employees are not allowed in the building during business hours
  - Aiken Shared Calendar does not need to be used during business hours
- 2. After-hours (after 6pm) and Weekend Access:
  - <u>All employees</u> that will be in the building outside of business hours must use Aiken Shared Calendar. This is to aid contact tracing if needed.
    - i. <u>Click this link to join</u> the Aiken team if you haven't already. The calendar is located in the "Building Access" tab.
    - **ii.** Make a reservation by adding your name and location within the building to the calendar.
    - **iii.** Please choose timeslots that are empty whenever possible to reduce risk of exposure.
  - <u>Remote employees</u> will need to fill out the <u>UVM Daily Health Check-in</u> on days they go into Aiken.
- 3. Common spaces in Aiken: Per our resumption plan submitted to the UVMStrong committee, most of the common spaces in Aiken will be closed for the semester including the kitchens, conference rooms, and the solarium. Signage inside the building will be placed to promote safe and healthy behavior. See the full plan here. If you see any non-compliance issues, please share your observations with the appropriate member of the RSENR Safety Team.
