- Office of The Provost

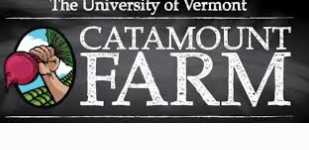

 Catamount Farm has generously donated three Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) shares to Staff Council for distribution among staff members throughout the season.

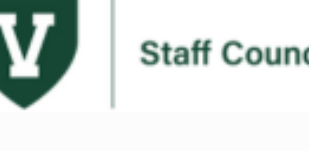

Green Mountain Transit Fares
GMT Fares Resume May 20th. What does this mean for UVMers?

Starting Monday, May 20th Green Mountain Transit will resume collecting fares on the following routes: Chittenden County local service, Chittenden County commuter service (Milton Commuter, Jeffersonville Commuter), and LINK Express service (Montpelier LINK, St. Albans LINK). For UVM riders to continue to ride fare free you must show your CatCard (virtual or physical) to the bus driver. This system will be in place until July 1, 2024. On or around, June 17, UVM will provide [eligible riders](#) with instructions on how to continue to access the fare free benefit after July 1.
