## COMPENSATION, BENEFITS AND BUDGET COMMITTEE

The Compensation, Benefits and Budget Committee last met on December 13<sup>th</sup>.

The Committee spent this meeting finalizing their proposal for the FY20 Non-Represented Staff Salary Increase Recommendations. The Committee has opted propose a discontinuation of the current merit procedures, based on projected budgets and staff feedback over the past five years of this process's implementation. These recommendations were presented to Staff Council for approval and delivered to administrators in December. The full memo will be distributed with the Staff Council meeting materials for January.

In addition, the Committee discussed upcoming goals for the spring semester and the upcoming year. These include a more comprehensive review of benefits in conjunction with Greg Paradiso, the development of presentations about parenting benefits at edu@uvm, and additional data-driven analyses of non-represented staff compensation.

## PERSONAL AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

The PPD Committee last met on December 18, 2018.

PPD members brainstormed on potential Staff Council contributions to edu@uvm. Major areas of need are self-advocacy, using one's voice, taking advantage of professional development and continuing education at UVM, and engaging with the performance review

process. The committee will prepare several proposals and plan to pilot a workshop at edu@uvm that could become a permanent offering. PPD may also investigate sponsoring a social event or reception that is less resource-intensive than last year's ice cream social, if funds are available.

PPD revisited the topic of instituting career counseling for non-represented staff. In the spring, they will connect with the Career Center to investigate options for this service. Members reported progress on discussing nursing spaces with campus stakeholders, but have also learned that no other governance group is currently engaging with this issue (though the Faculty Senate is supportive of Staff Council's efforts to further support parents on campus).

The next meeting of the PPD committee is scheduled for Tuesday, January 15th, 2018 at 11 a.m. in the Rosa Parks Room (106E), Davis Center.
