### Application

#### Purpose

This scholarship is for undergraduate student veterans at UVM who have financial need, are pursuing an undergraduate degree, and are an active or former member of any military branch.

Priority will be given to active or former US Marines, Purple Heart Recipients, a veteran who served in a combat zone, and veterans with two or more years of service.

\$19,000 is available per year with a maximum of 3 recipients per term.

Applicants may re-apply for subsequent terms.
