 - the likelihood that the nominee will achieve her/his stated goals during the award period
 - options for alternative funding of the student for the summer award period,
 - the student's access to and expected interaction with her/his advisor and/or other faculty supervision during the summer award period.

4. List all sources of funding the student has had, including Graduate College assistantship funding, since beginning the degree program, along with any existing or potential sources of support for this summer's research or project work.
