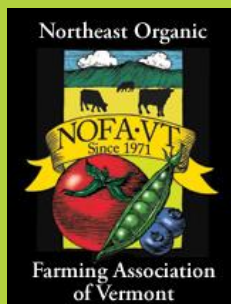


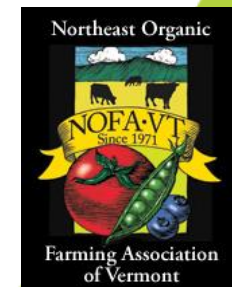
Keeping a Focus on Equity and Access in Local Food Systems

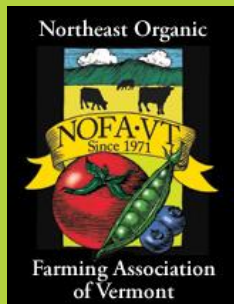
