

- 1. Food CGMP Inspection
- 2. Limited Scope Inspection
- 3. Full Scope Inspection
- 4. Modified Requirement of Qualified Facilities
- 5. Modified Requirement at facilities solely engaged of unexposed packaged food that require time/temp controls for food safety



- There are various ways to access the information. Available information is based on fields from <u>Form FDA 3942a</u> (for Human Food) or <u>Form FDA 3942b</u> (for Animal Food).
- **Option 1.** If you have the ability to customize ORADSS reports, then Qualifying Facility Self-Attestation objects are available to query in ORADSS FIRM universe under Firms QFA folder (Screen shot below).



## PC.16 Does the final rule include provisions to appeal the withdrawal of a qualified facility exemption?

Yes. The final rule provides procedures for a facility to appeal the withdrawal order and request an informal hearing. And there is a procedure for reinstating an exemption that was withdrawn. Attaching Subpart E relative to withdrawal.





  - Limited to no data of business e.g. sales, products (unable to determine inspection scope for planning)


