• In 2011 FSMA was signed into legislation





- Collaborative Education and Training Projects Max budget \$550,000





 - Log in to ASAP
 - Hover over Payment Requests and select Initiate Payment Requests from drop down
 - Complete the 4 steps to initiate the request
- Transaction Options
 - Select ACH for next day settlement
 - Select Fedwire for same day settlement



Trouble Accessing ASAP Account?

- Is the ASAP account suspended?
 - ASAP accounts are suspended during the last 4 business days of every month to allow for month-end reconciliations
 - Administrative issues may include not fulfilling all Grantee responsibilities, improper draw downs, and funding issues
 - Performance period expired, contact <u>Awards@usda.gov</u>
- Is the ASAP account closed?
 - Final SF-425 and Grant Report have been submitted and approved
 - Administratively closed due to non-compliance with Terms & Conditions
- ASAP log in issues?
 - To stay active in ASAP log in every 45 days
