

**Semester Break Faculty/Staff Parking & Campus Shuttle Guidance
November 25, 2020 through January 31, 2021:**

Parking rules and regulations remain in effect with the exception of the University's [Administrative Holiday](#) schedule. Time and location restrictions may be modified, but all motor vehicles must continue to display a valid parking permit.

Leaving a Motor Vehicle on Campus While Away.

- With the exception of employees residing in campus housing, faculty/staff permits are not allowed overnight parking unless authorized in advance by the University, usually for University business travel. Vehicles parked overnight without authorization may be relocated to another on-campus location without notice. Temporary exceptions may be granted only upon request. Please email parking@uvm.edu or call 802-656-8686.
- If you reside in campus housing and need to leave your permitted motor vehicle parked while you are away, please park as follows. To allow for snow removal, maintenance, and possible locations needed for emergency response, do not leave your vehicle parked in its assigned residential area or your vehicle may be relocated to another on-campus location at your expense without notice. Valid employee permits of any color designation are allowed parking within the Gutterson Garage.
- The upper deck above the Gutterson Garage is closed to overnight parking from 11:00 pm-7:00 am, November 15th through April 1st. Your vehicle must be parked within the enclosed sections of the garage in the middle or lower levels and not in any of the unenclosed surface areas of the facility if you are away during this period or your vehicle may be relocated at your expense.

Daily Parking Needs.

- During this period, all valid permits will be allowed parking in all campus parking lots.
- Please watch for signs and your UVM email and park accordingly in regards to lot closures, snow removal, maintenance and possible emergency response locations.
- Employees may park in the pay-by-app/visitor spaces by payment during restricted hours.
- Motorist assistance, motor vehicle jump-starts and lock-outs if parked on campus, will be available by calling Parking Services at 802-656-8686 during business hours, Mon-Thurs from 7:30 am-4:00 pm and until 3:00 pm on Fridays. Please call Police Services at 802-343-8735 after hours and Administrative Holidays.
