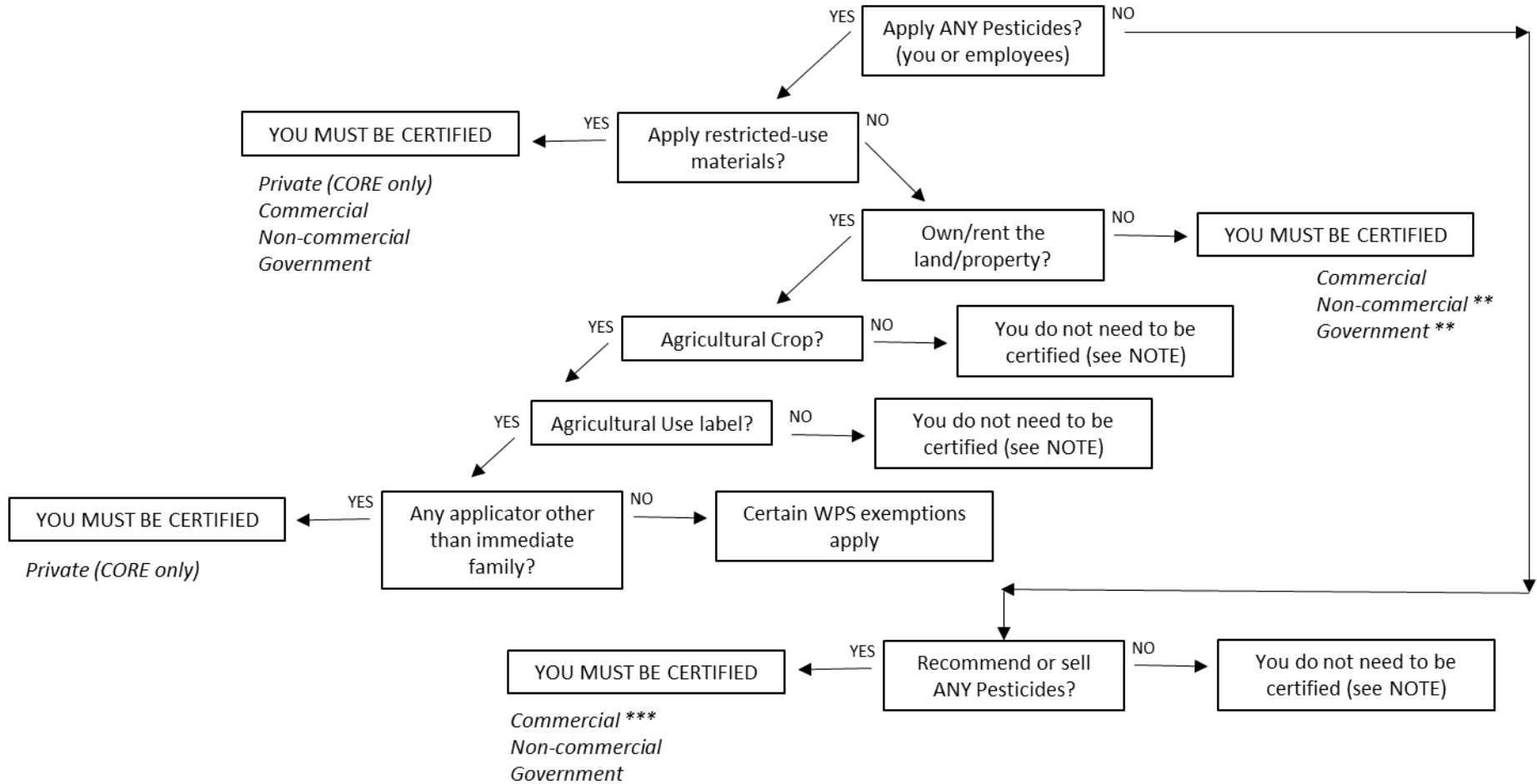


DO I NEED TO BE CERTIFIED? *



* If you work under DIRECT SUPERVISION of someone who is certified, you do not need to be certified yourself.

** Non-commercial and Government employees only need to be certified if applying Class A or B pesticides (and/or recommending ANY pesticide).

*** Those that sell pesticides to the end-user in Vermont from a company outside of Vermont, as a traveling salesperson, must be certified. ANY activity other than sales (calibrate, etc.) requires *Commercial* certification.

NOTE: This flowchart does not address all situations. Please double-check with the Vermont Agency of Agriculture, Food & Markets to verify certification requirements
