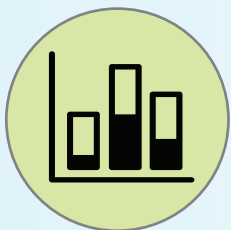
Who We Are

How We're Funded

In FY22, UVM Extension's funding came from federal (\$2,372,258) and state (\$5,881,749) appropriations, grants and contracts (\$14,941,870), sales and fees (\$444,415), and gifts and endowments (\$421,996).
