1. Application for Stallion Station Service must be made prior to March 15, 2019. Please call Kim Demars to request collection service at (802) 388-2011. For the purposes of this agreement, unless otherwise specified for a particular stallion, the breeding season shall begin March 15 and close July 15 of the year on this agreement.

2. All stallions must have proof of vaccinations for Eastern & Western Equine Encephalitis, Tetanus, Influenza, Rhinopneumonitis, West Nile, Potomac, and Rabies **30 days** prior to arrival. All stallions must have proof of a current negative Coggins test (within 6 months) prior to arrival. All stallions from outside the State of Vermont need a certificate of veterinary inspection (health certificate).

3. The collection fee is \$300 per collection. Board for stallions left at the Farm is \$25.00/day- payable before the stallion is released from the UVM Morgan Horse Farm. All farrier and/or veterinary expenses the stallion incurs while at the UVM Morgan Horse Farm will be charged to the owner- payable before the stallion is released from the UVM Morgan Horse Farm.
4. Collection fee includes collection, evaluation, and processing of semen, and overnight shipping. An additional fee of \$100/hr. may be charged if the stallion requires longer than 45 minutes to become oriented to the phantom or to collect. Additional, inseminations processed from one collection will be charged at \$50/dose.
5. Collection days are Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. No exceptions will be made. To guarantee, shipping, mare owner, or agent, must give **at least** 24-hour notice of their need for semen. Please arrange to have mares checked on Sunday, Tuesday, and Thursday to schedule shipments accordingly. Stallion owner is responsible for mare recipient contracts, fees and liability.
6. All fees must be paid in advance of the shipment of semen. Fees to be paid by certified check, credit card or money order. It will be required to put a credit card on file.
7. The University of Vermont Morgan Horse Farm and its employees are not liable for any loss of, or damage sustained by, an outside stallion. The owner should insure privately owned stallions, and proof of the same is required at time of arrival. The client is exempt from liability in the event that the client’s horse causes property damage to the facilities or physical injury or death to any personnel while at the UVM Morgan Horse Farm.
