1. For the purposes of this agreement, unless otherwise specified for a particular mare, the breeding season shall begin March 15 and close July 15 of the year on this agreement.

2. A \$300 non-refundable Booking Fee must be returned with this contract. The remainder of the stud fee (\$1200) is due prior to the first collection of semen. If the mare requires more than one collection of semen to settle, a \$200 collection fee must be paid prior to any additional collections.

3. Live Foal Guarantee: Should the Mare not produce a live foal (stands & nurses) from this breeding season, the Mare Owner is entitled to ONE return breeding privilege the following season with a \$300 re-booking fee. A statement of the details of the Foal's death by a licensed

vet must follow within 10 days or the guarantee becomes null and void. The stallion owner has the option to:

- a. Re-breed the mare the following season only under the terms of this contract.
 - b. Accept a substitute mare under the terms of this contract for one season.
4. Should the above named Stallion or Mare die or become unfit for service before the condition of this agreement are met, this Contract will be null and void, and the stud fee minus the booking fee will be returned.
 5. Mare Owner shall assume all responsibility for the condition of the Mare and shall bear all risk of loss or damage to her, whether by any cause whatsoever and, therefore, agrees to hold the University of Vermont Morgan Horse Farm (or any person associated with the University of Vermont Morgan Horse Farm) harmless for any and all damages associated therewith.

I, _____, the undersigned, agree to the aforementioned stipulations. Also, I release the University of Vermont Morgan Horse Farm at its employees/associates and the State of Vermont from any liabilities relative to any animal(s) that have been entered under these terms.
