



Stallion Booking Contract

This is a contract between the University of Vermont (hereinafter referred to the Stallion Owner) and _____ (hereinafter referred to the Mare Owner) to breed the following mare to **UVM Unchallenged**, AMHA Registration #185182. The contract is valid only for the _____ season.

This contract is subject to the following terms and conditions. Failure to abide by these conditions will nullify all guarantees and no further semen will be shipped.

1. For the purposes of this agreement, unless otherwise specified for a particular mare, the breeding season shall begin March 15 and close June 15 of the year on this agreement.
2. A \$300 non-refundable Booking Fee must be returned with this contract. The remainder of the stud fee (\$1200) is due prior to the first collection of semen.



3. A collection fee of \$300 will be charged for each shipment of semen. This fee includes the cost of collection and use of a shipping container. Overnight shipping fees are NOT included and will be an additional charge. *UVM Morgan Horse Farm is unable to ship via airlines counter to counter service.*
4. A minimum 24 hour notice is required for semen shipment. Collection days are Monday through Friday.
5. Prior to the shipment of semen, the Mare Owner is required to:
 - a. Forward a veterinary certificate to the Stallion Owner, confirming the Mare to be in sound breeding condition and free of infection. The certificate must be issued within 30 days prior to the first semen shipment or insemination.
 - b. Examine the Mare for pregnancy between 14-35 days post breeding and notify the results to the Stallion Owner.
6. The Mare Owner is responsible for all veterinarian charges related to the pregnancy of the Mare.
7. The Mare Owner assumes all responsibility for the condition of the Mare and shall bear all risk of loss or damage to the Mare, whether by death, disease, infection, injury or otherwise and by any cause whatsoever, and therefore agrees to hold the Stallion Owner, harmless for any and all damages associated therewith.
8. Live Foal Guarantee: Should the Mare not produce a live foal (stands & nurses) from this breeding season, the Mare Owner is entitled to ONE return breeding privilege the following season with a \$300 re-booking fee. In the event that the Mare is unable to produce a live foal, the stallion owner has the option to:
 - a. Re-breed the mare the following season only under the terms of this contract.
 - b. Accept a substitute mare under the terms of this contract for one season.
9. A statement of the details of the Foal's death by a licensed vet must follow within 10 days or the live foal guarantee becomes null and void. If additional live foals result from the use of semen acquired under this contract, the Mare Owner agrees to pay the Stallion Owner a full-service fee per additional live foal within 30 days of foaling date.
10. Should the above named Stallion die or become unfit for service before the condition of this agreement are met, this Contract will be null and void, and the stud fee minus the booking fee will be returned. Should the above Mare die before being served, the Mare Owner has the right to substitute a different Mare.
11. It is required that the University of Vermont Morgan Horse Farm is given the dates of insemination so that all records are accurate. This contract is valid for the current breeding season only.
