1. Application for Mare Station Service must be made prior to March 15, 2019. Please call Kim Demars to request mare station service at (802) 388-2011. For the purposes of this agreement, unless otherwise specified for a particular mare, the breeding season shall begin March 15 and close July 15 of the year on this agreement.

2. All mares must have proof of vaccinations for Eastern & Western Equine Encephalitis, Tetanus, Influenza, Rhinopneumonitis, West Nile, Potomac, and Rabies **30 days** prior to arrival. All mares must have proof of a current negative Coggins test (within 6 months) prior to arrival. All nonmaiden mares must have a current uterine culture report. Mares from outside the State of Vermont need a certificate of veterinary inspection (health certificate) presented at arrival.
3. Board is \$20/day for Mare and \$25/day for Mare and foal – payable prior to the release of the Mare from UVM.
4. Should the Mare not produce a live foal (stands & nurses) from this breeding season, the Mare Owner is entitled to ONE return breeding privilege the following season along with a \$300 re-booking fee.
5. Should the above named Stallion or Mare die or become unfit for service before the condition of this agreement are met, this Contract will be null and void.
6. All farrier and/or veterinary expenses the mare incurs while at the UVM Morgan Horse Farm will be charged to the owner-payable before the mare is released from the UVM Morgan Horse Farm.
7. Mare Owner shall assume all responsibility for the condition of the Said Mare and shall bear all risk of loss or damage to her whether by death, disease, injury, infection, or by any cause whatsoever and, therefore, agrees to hold the University of Vermont Morgan Horse Farm, (or any person associated with the University of Vermont Morgan Horse Farm), harmless for any and all damages associated therewith.
