1. Application for Stallion Station Service must be made prior to March 15, 2024. Please call Jamie Maguire to request collection service at (802) 388-2011. For the purposes of this agreement, unless otherwise specified for a particular stallion, the breeding season shall begin March 15 and close June 15 of the year on this agreement.

 All stallions must have proof of vaccinations for Eastern & Western Equine Encephalitis, Tetanus, Influenza, Rhinopneumonitis, West Nile, Potomac, and Rabies <u>30 days</u> prior to arrival. All stallions must have proof of a current negative Coggins test (within 12 months) prior to arrival. All stallions from outside the State of Vermont need a certificate of veterinary inspection (health certificate).



- 3. A one-time \$400 fee will be charged to train the stallion to the phantom mount. This fee will include an initial evaluation of stallion semen and assessment of its suitability for semen shipment.
- 4. The collection fee is \$350. Collection fee includes collection, evaluation, and processing of semen. Fee includes the use of a shipping container. Overnight shipping fees are NOT included and will be an additional charge. Additional inseminations processed from one collection will be charged at \$100/dose. UVM Morgan Horse Farm is unable to ship via airlines counter to counter service.
- 5. Board for stallions left at the Farm is \$25.00/day-payable before the stallion is released from the UVM Morgan Horse Farm. All farrier and/or veterinary expenses the stallion incurs while at the UVM Morgan Horse Farm will be charged to the owner-payable before the stallion is released from the UVM Morgan Horse Farm.
- 6. Collection days are Monday Friday. Mare owner or agent must give at least 24-hour notice of their need for semen shipment. Non-boarded stallions are NOT guaranteed a collection time, but every effort will be made to accommodate if possible. Stallion owner is responsible for breeding contracts and collection fees with mare owner.
- 7. All fees must be paid in advance of the shipment of semen. Fees to be paid by certified check, credit card or money order. It will be required to put a credit card on file.
- 8. The University of Vermont Morgan Horse Farm and its employees are not liable for any loss of, or damage sustained by, an outside stallion. The owner should insure privately owned stallions, and proof of the same is required at time of arrival. The client is exempt from liability in the event that the client's horse causes property damage to the facilities or physical injury or death to any personnel while at the UVM Morgan Horse Farm.
