

#### The U.S. Tribal Nations

- 59M acres of land in Indian Country are engaged in food and agriculture
- Most of the value of that product leaves Tribal lands and communities and doesn't return
- 20M of the 26M acres in Arizona involved in food and agriculture are under direct Tribal control
- Largest contiguous farm in the US is the Navajo Agricultural Products Industry (NAPI)
- Top 10 farms in SD, AZ, NM, OR, WA, CA, ID, etc. are Tribal farms






