


Women Farmers in the United States



Share of female operated farms (%)

(0.00, 9.19) (9.19, 12.34) (12.34, 17.19) (17.19, 30.43) (30.43, 44.57) (44.57, 100.00)

- Issues: access to land and credit, networks, childcare, multiple roles on the farm (Ball, 2019)
- "Farming is one of the most unequal professions in the United States today" (Fremstad and Paul, 2020: p.124).
- Higher share of female farmers: population centers, horticultural and small livestock production, agritourism (Schmidt et al, 2021)
- Female farmers & agritourism (van Sandt et al, 2019)



Women in Agritourism - Research

- Less economically successful: Female AT operators "make less gross income than their male counterparts" (Barbieri & Mshenga, 2008).
- Women are more interested in "expense reducing" than "income- inducing" activities (McGehee et al, 2007); Different aims (Halim, 2016)
- "Attributes at the personal, farm household, and society levels predict women's perceived functional success and the importance of different life aspects to their success" (Savage et al., 2020)
- Reinforce the traditional gendered role of agriculture and typical "women's work" (Wright and Annes, 2020; Garcia-Ramon et al. 1995).

National Agritourism Survey - Results Overview



Females (809 responses – 57%)

were 54 years old (average age)

73% had a college degree

farmed 50 acres (median farm size)

43% had 10+ years experience in agritourism

Males

(598 responses – 43%)

were 57 years old (average age)

66% had a college degree


farmed 75 acres (median farm size)




Categories of Farm Experiences










Percent of respondents who rated goal as very important or important


