

## **FACTS & FIGURES 2016-2017**

### **ENROLLMENT AND SIZE**

- 10,267 undergraduates
- 1,462 graduate students, 461 medical students, 23 post-baccalaureate certificates, 892 non-degree students
- 15:1 undergraduate student/faculty ratio
- 98% of classes are taught by faculty (only 2% by graduate assistants)
- 80% of classes have fewer than 40 students; 52% of classes have fewer than 20 students; average class size: 30

### **DIVERSITY**

- 11.2% of undergraduates are ALANA; 27% of medical students and 5.7% of graduate students are ALANA
- Undergraduates by race/ethnicity: African American: 127; Native American: 9; Asian or Pacific Islander: 284; Latino/a: 404; multiracial: 324
- 28% of undergraduates are Vermont residents; 50% of graduate and certificate students are Vermont residents; 27.5% of medical students are Vermont residents
- All 14 Vermont counties are represented in the undergraduate population; 46% of Vermont students are from Chittenden County
- 5.1% of undergraduates are international students
- 96 student veterans

### **PROGRAM OFFERINGS**

- 100+ bachelor's degree programs
- 50 master's degree programs
- 22 doctoral programs

### **EXPERIENCE-BASED LEARNING**

- 91% of seniors report being engaged in research, an internship or other experience-based learning/high impact practice while at UVM
  - 38% of seniors report involvement in research with a faculty mentor
  - 600 study abroad options in 70 countries; 32% of undergraduates studied abroad
  - 99 service-learning courses

## CAMPUS LIFE

- 40+ programmed housing offerings
- 47% of students live in programmed housing
- 200+ clubs and organizations, including 25 service clubs promoting health, literacy, and/or social justice
- 18 Division I athletic teams; 54 club sports

## SCHOLARSHIPS AND FINANCIAL AID

- 85% of undergraduates receive scholarships or financial aid; 31% overall undergraduate tuition discount rate not including tuition remission
- \$33 million in grants and scholarships awarded to first-time, first-year undergraduates and transfer students, including fall and spring admits
- \$103.8 million total UVM support (loans plus grants and scholarships) awarded to all undergraduates
- Average loan indebtedness: \$25,359 for in-state students; \$30,632 for out-of-state students
- 38% of in-state students and 48% of out-of-state students graduated without loans
- 27% of in-state undergraduates are Pell Grant recipients; 13% of out-of-state students are Pell Grant recipients

## STUDENT OUTCOMES

- First-year student retention: 86.4%
- Four-year graduation rate: 64%
- 93% of graduates were employed or continuing their education within six months of graduation\*
- 77% of graduates were employed within six months of graduation\*
- 16% of UVM graduates were continuing their education within six months of graduation\*
- Admit rate to medical school: 53% (national rate: 43%), Admit rate to law school: 92% (national rate: 77%); Admit rate to veterinary school: 100% (national rate 50%)
- 116 students have won or been finalists in scholarship competitions ranging from the Fulbright to the Goldwater in the last five years
- #6: UVM ranking for the number of graduates who enter the Peace Corps (among medium-sized schools)
