



Summer Undergraduate Research Awards

Background

The Environmental Program at UVM is a university-wide interdisciplinary program encouraging high impact learning and active student engagement in building a sustainable future.

To meet that mission, the Program offers summer research awards of up to \$3,000 (for salary and/or expenses) to UVM undergraduate students conducting environmentally related research.

The student should have the direct support and supervision of a researcher who is knowledgeable and qualified to support the proposed research effort. Though preference will be given to Environmental Studies majors, these awards are open to any student in any major, as long as the proposed project is research on an environmental issue.

Submissions should be made electronically by 5:00 p.m. on **March 29** to the Director of the Environmental Program, Nathan Sanders (Nathan.Sanders@uvm.edu). If you have any questions, please contact Dr. Sanders.

Awards will be announced in mid April.

Application process

Interested students should submit the following in a single PDF file by 5:00 p.m. on **March 29**. Only full submissions will be considered.

Please submit a **single PDF file** containing the following elements:

1. Cover page with title, student name, major, college, year, and 3-sentence summary of the proposed project
2. A one-page work plan for the summer ending August 31 that will guide the student's research activities. Please explain how many hours you expect to work, and how you intend to allocate those to the specific tasks and subtasks within your research.
3. A statement (up to 2 pages) by the student specifying their interest, qualifications and ability to address the research proposed and their interest (and plan) in continuing the research beyond the summer.
4. The student's current resume (including GPA).
5. An endorsement of the research plan and student by a researcher or faculty member, stating how they know the student, how qualified the student is to carry out the work, why the research is important, how it links with their own research and what role they will play (if any) in the proposed research.

Criteria

Preference will be given to proposals that:

1. Clearly address an environmental research topic with sound methodology.
2. Support an undergraduate student with the skills and motivation capable of carrying out the research.
3. Connect to a mentor who has a demonstrated record of environmental related research and evidence of engaging with undergraduate students.
4. Are submitted by a student who is an ENVS major.

Timeline

Selection decision announced by **mid-April**

Summer — research conducted

Research report submitted by **Sept 15**

Post award requirements

1. Submit a report summarizing completed activities (3-5 pages) by September 15.
2. Acknowledge the **Environmental Program** in related publications or activities.
3. Participate actively in communicating their experience, e.g. presenting at conferences, speaking in classes and (required) attending UVM's Student Research Day.
4. Must be a degree student and not have graduated by Sept 1.
