

## REQUEST TO DEFER GRADUATE DEGREE ADMISSION

The initial request must be submitted directly to the office of Graduate Admissions, who will forward it to your program for review and approval.

It **cannot** be used for the following:

- Non-degree applicants
- Denied applicants
- Applicants who were cancelled due to their file never being completed
- Applicants who have already deferred their original application (Only one deferral per application is permitted).
