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The Board of Trustees Educational Policy and Institutional Resources Committee approved the following changes to the Academic Programs effective May 22, 2010:

- A Bachelor of Arts in Linguistics was created.
- The Department of Communication Sciences was renamed to the Department of Communication Sciences and Disorder, and moved from the College of Arts and Sciences to the College of Nursing and Health Sciences.
- A Bachelor of Science in Communication Sciences and Disorders was created.
- The graduate degree Master of Science in Communication Sciences was renamed to the Master of Science in Communication Sciences and Disorder.
- The Minor in Studio Art was eliminated.

All the changes approved by the Board of Trustees will be reflected in the 2011-12 Catalogue.

Grading: (Online Catalogue: Printable PDF Catalogue - Page 26, Grading, first column): The following paragraph has been removed:

XC: This grade is assigned when the nature of the course work makes it unreasonable or impossible for the student to complete the required work within the regular semester.

Grading (Online Catalogue: Printable PDF Catalogue - Page 26, Grading, second column, inserted before the last paragraph): SP/UP: These grades are used in courses with a linkage in credits in multiple semesters. Neither SP nor UP will be included in the student's GPA. The grade of SP will be assigned when a student has made satisfactory progress during a semester prior to the final semester of the linked courses; credit will be awarded with the grade of SP. The grade of UP will be assigned when the student's progress has been unsatisfactory and no credit will be awarded. The faculty member may change the grade of SP to a letter grade once the final grade for the multiple semester work is completed. A grade of SP cannot be changed to a UP based on a student not completing the final semester's work satisfactorily.
