- 1) A \$250 Booking Fee (non-refundable) and a \$250 Equitainer Deposit (refundable) must be returned with this contract. A \$20/day penalty will be charged if the Equitainer is not returned to UVM within 7 days from the date received by Mare Owner or Vet. If door-to-door overnight service is not available, or if the UVM Farm was not notified of needing semen in time to make an overnight delivery service deadline, a \$50 travel charge will be added for an airport delivery of the semen shipment, in addition to the flight costs. The Stallion Owner will make all shipping arrangements. The Mare Owner is responsible for all vet charges related to pregnancy of the Mare.
- 2) A Veterinarian's certificate of health must accompany all Mare (s) to the Farm. Included must be proof of vaccination against Eastern Equine Encephalomyelitis, a negative Coggins test plus flu, rhino and rabies vaccinations, and a current uterine culture report.

- 3) **RATES:** A \$250 Booking Fee must be returned with this contract. This Fee is deducted from the Stud Fee at a 55-day pregnancy confirmation. Board is \$8/day for Mare and \$10/day for Mare and foal – payable prior to the release of the Mare from UVM.

All blacksmith and/or vet expenses Mare incurs while at the Farm will be the responsibility of the Mare Owner – payable prior to the release of Mare from UVM.

When the Mare is checked in-foal at 55 days from the last breeding, the balance of the Stud Fee is due. Should the Mare not produce a live foal (stands & nurses) from this breeding season, the Mare Owner is entitled to return breeding privileges the following season at no additional cost, other than vet/board/blacksmith expenses.

- 4) We recommend that the Mare be left at the UVM Morgan Horse Farm to be checked for pregnancy status.
- 5) Should the Mare Owner not pay any charges or fees due under the obligation of this contract, the UVM Morgan Horse reserves the right to claim the Mare (should the services rendered equal the evaluation of the animal) or demand payment.
- 6) Should the above named Stallion or Mare die or become unfit for service before the condition of this agreement are met, this Contract will be null and void.
