This case study examined the effects of Comic Strip Conversations (CSCs) and Social Stories to remediate behavioral regulation difficulties (i.e., inappropriate touching such as pinching) in an 8-year-old child with Autism Syndrome Disorder (ASD). Using an ABACA single-subject design, quantitative subjective ratings of behavior change and qualitative data (comments), were collected in the form of daily diaries completed by the child's mother. Visual analysis of maternal ratings across the ABACA phases will indicate if the interventions had an effect on the child's behavioral regulation.
