Abstract

The purpose of this poster is to report findings of a comprehensive study of multifunctional farming operations in New England. The study shows that small farmers are involved in multifunctional activities that allow them to use existing resources to supplement their farming operations. The study clearly shows that small farmers are involved in broadening, deepening and regrounding activities including direct sales, value added, agritourism and off farm income endeavors. The study provides much needed insight and specification into these activities and provides important new implications for academics, practitioners and policy makers locally, regionally and nationally.
