Describe in some detail the plans to address specific aims (3-5 pages). Be sure to make clear where undergraduates, if any, participate in the research. Address future research directions for your research.

If in disciplines outside Chemistry, Biology and Psychology, explain how the work could indirectly or directly inform biomedical research.

A time line for the research will be especially important for summer research funding applications (<1 page).

#### **Obligations That Will Come with Funding:**

- If awarded summer research support your attendance is expected at the 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual VGN Retreat in August of 2004.
- Please note that due to a change in our grant year-end date (assigned by NIH) we have to compress our full awards into a short time period. Therefore, award funds will begin on May 15, 2004 and *must* be expended by June 30, 2004.
- You will be expected to provide a report by September 15, 2004 detailing your research progress, roles of undergraduates (if appropriate) and the impact of your research on undergraduate science education.
- You will also be expected to submit a research grant application to a federal or comparable extramural agency by June 1, 2005.
- You will be expected to complete an annual VGN survey.
- All participants will be asked to be part of our mentoring activities for undergraduates and faculty across the state.
